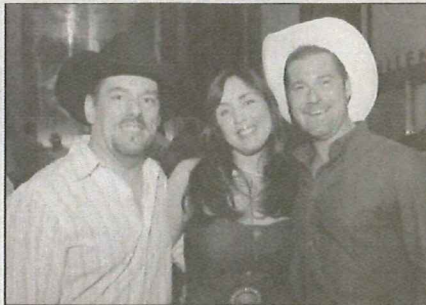
On Friday night, the Children's Crisis Treatment Center (CcTC) held its 2008 Roundup at Loews Philadelphia Hotel.

All proceeds from the evening benefited CcTC, which is committed to providing high-quality, comprehensive mental and behavioral health services to Philadelphia's children and their families. These services



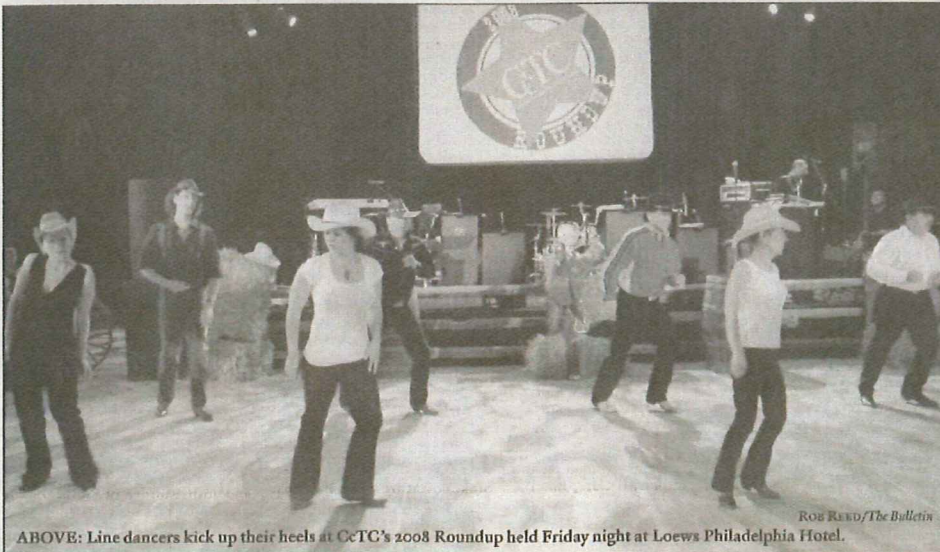
